Criterion:

Eye contact: focus on the listener



Proximity of the listeners to the teller is essential.

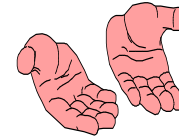
Narration:

a character or another person describes a point of view, the setting, characters, and any changes.



Characterization:

visualize the images use dialogue, voice expression, sound effects, face expressions and hand and body motions create familiar images for the listeners.



Score Level	Score level description	Storytelling specific description
1	The student demonstrates Little or no apparent understanding about the important concepts and generalizations about storytelling techniques.	Feet movement, aimless walking used as Storytelling techniques, and no characterization.
